Bath Canada Day 2018 vendors' market held at
Centennial Park, Bath on **Sunday July 1st 2018**

The fee to participate can be found on the vendor registration form.

(Power outlets are limited. Bring your own extension cord.
Covering mats are required to avoid tripping)

The theme this year is: **Bath Rocks on Canada Day**

- 1) Vendor spaces will be allocated on a first come basis and will only be confirmed once your completed registration form, certificate of insurance, and full payment have been received.
- 2) **On Line Registration.** Again this year for your convenience you may complete the application on line and remit the fee with your credit card. (Plus \$2.00 convenience fee)
Full details can be found on the registration form.

3) Confirmation of Registration

Once we receive your, completed application form, full payment, **Certificate of Insurance** or insurance payment you will receive an email confirmation and a site map with your location.

Vendor Instructions

- Each space is 12' x 12' unless other arrangements have been made prior to date.
- The Market opens at 9:00 a.m. and runs to 5:00 p.m.
- All vendors must enter and leave the park via the driveway from Fairfield Avenue.

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- Volunteers will be in the park between 7:30 – 9:00 a.m. to assist you.
- Set up must be completed by 8:30 and vehicles moved into designated parking areas
- Vendors are required to supply their own shelter, tables, chairs and water if needed.
- Vendors may be required to unload from the street if the grounds are soft due to rain.
- Food vendors will be allowed to drive into the east side of the park
- Vendors must **remove their own garbage** at the end of the day.

4) **Food vendors**

- **ALL food vendors** must fill out a “Special Event Application” to obtain a permit from the Public Health Unit in Napanee.
