



Bath Canada Day Liability Insurance Information for Vendors

As the annual Bath Canada Day event continues to grow in its success, the increased risk to participants also grows. To ensure that you are adequately protected Loyalist Township has made liability Insurance a **mandatory requirement for ALL vendors**.

Public liability insurance provides the insured with coverage for third party liability claims resulting in injury and/or damage to property. Many vendors (registered businesses) will already hold the appropriate insurance liability.

Please contact your insurance agent requesting the following:-

"A minimum \$2 million liability policy on an occurrence form naming The Corporation of Loyalist Township - 263 Main Street, Odessa, ON K0H 2H0 as ADDITIONAL INSURED"

You must provide a copy with your application.

Vendors bringing live animals must provide their own liability insurance.

ALL other Vendors may provide their own insurance that has been independently arranged **OR** it may be provided as part of the coverage afforded to Loyalist Township by Frank Cowan Company. See the registration form for full details.
